

Health & Safety Policy

Classrooms and school facilities

- ✓ Students will be organised in bubble groups.
- ✓ Children will participate in sport activities without masks but will wear masks when participating in artistic activities.
- ✓ Drinking fountains will be closed. Students must bring a properly marked bottle of water that they can fill up at school when they need it, following the instructions of school staff.
- ✓ All students must bring their own face mask and a bag to keep it in whenever they are not using it.
- ✓ All school staff will wear the PPE established by the health authorities for the safety of students, teachers and non-teaching staff.
- ✓ During lunch, each child will eat at an assigned place.

Hygiene measures

- ✓ Sinks with soap and disposable paper towels will be available to all pupils to encourage good hygiene during the day.
- ✓ Classrooms will be thoroughly cleaned with sanitising products every day.
- ✓ There will be constant air flow and room ventilation during the day, keeping windows and doors open.
- ✓ Washrooms and surfaces that are touched regularly (door handles, switches, offices, computer equipment, drinking fountains, taps, etc.) will be cleaned with sanitising products.

Health measures

Please check your child's temperature at home every morning and do not send your child to school if they have a temperature of 37 or higher or show any symptoms of illness.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, no person with the following symptoms may come to school:

- ✓ Temperature of 37 or above
- ✓ Any symptom of illness
- ✓ Anyone with family members at home with symptoms of COVID-19
- ✓ Anyone who has been in contact with someone testing positive for COVID-19 within the previous 48 hours.

Protocol in case a student displays COVID-19 related symptoms

- ✓ Parents must be prepared to pick up their sick child from school within 30/60 minutes of a call from the Nurse.
- ✓ Students with fever or symptoms compatible with COVID-19 will wait in a specific room, wearing a face mask, until they can be picked up by their parents/guardian.
- ✓ Students with a fever of 37^o or higher will be sent home and should consult with their pediatrician or general practitioner, for further instructions. Parents must inform the school of the diagnosis.
- ✓ If a student tests positive for COVID-19, parents will inform the school, the school nurse will inform the National Health system and will provide parents and school staff with pertinent indications.
