

Health & Safety Policy

Depending on the measures that government health and educational agencies adopt in relation to the evolution of the Covid 19 pandemic, these summer programmes may be altered or cancelled.

Classrooms and school facilities

- ✓ Primary students will work and move in bubbles, and Secondary students will remain 1.2 m apart from one another.
- ✓ Infants, as well as NU and RE students must wear a mask when entering and leaving the school. Inside the school, they will work and move in "bubbles", so they can be without a mask in class and during the playground.
- ✓ From 6 years old (Primary/Year 1) onwards, students must wear a face mask at all times.
- ✓ Drinking fountains will be closed. Students must bring a properly marked bottle of water that they can fill up at school when they need it, following the instructions of school staff.
- ✓ All students must bring their own face mask and a bag to keep it in whenever they are not using it.
- ✓ In Primary and Secondary each student will sit on a dedicated space.
- ✓ All school staff will wear the PPE established by authorities for the safety of students, teachers and rest of staff.
- ✓ Groups will take their recess and move about the school at different times.
- ✓ During lunch, children will eat in a designated space.
- ✓ Circulation paths will be clearly marked to avoid the crossing of students in the areas of greatest circulation.
- ✓ The capacity of the pool has been reduced and 4 new changing rooms have been opened to ensure the safety distance between students.
- ✓ During pool time, areas to leave towels, flip flops, etc., will be clearly demarcated to keep the required interpersonal separation.

Hygiene measures

- ✓ Hand hygiene will be performed when entering the school, before and after each recess, before and after eating food, and when leaving the school.
- ✓ There will be constant air flow and room ventilation during the day, keeping windows and doors open.
- ✓ Dining room tables will be cleaned after each group rotation.
- ✓ Washrooms are cleaned with sanitizing products several times a day.

Health measures

Please check temperature at home daily and do not send your child to school if they have a temperature of 37 or higher, or show symptoms of illness.

Students showing the following symptoms are not allowed to come to school during COVID-19 pandemic:

- ✓ Students with a temperature of 37 or above
- ✓ Students with symptoms of illness
- ✓ Active vomiting or diarrhea

Protocol in case a student displays COVID-19 related symptoms

- ✓ Parents must be prepared to pick up their sick child from school within 30/60 minutes of a call from the Nurse.
- ✓ Students with fever or symptoms compatible with COVID-19 will wait in a specific room, wearing a face mask, until they can be picked up by their parents/guardian. Parents will receive indications from the school nurse on how to proceed.
- ✓ If a student tests positive for COVID-19, parents will inform the school, the school nurse will provide parents and school staff with pertinent indications.
